There was no significant difference between girls and boys – girls generally have to be struggling more than boys to be recommended for a special school.

There was no significant difference between Disadvantaged and Non-Disadvantaged; however, in spite of achieving on average a slightly greater number of qualifications, 'disadvantaged' students achieved less Grade 4+ qualifications.

Students receiving Pupil Premium Plus funding achieved more qualifications, more GCSEs, more GCSEs and equivalents and more Grade 4+ qualifications. This shows we have high expectations for our CLA students.
