5	Explore local college websites looking at facilities for students, interactive tour of campus and identify courses students may be interested in.	Pupils to make their own refreshments independently. Pupils to use the washing machine and then demonstrate how to hang wet washing.
6	Pupils to visit Cheshire College for a campus tour Pupils to evaluate their trip using Xello.
